Initial Assessment

- Defining immigration goals
- General evaluation of personal circumstances

Career and Professional Evaluation

- Assessing work experience and skills to match the destination country's needs

Educational Assessment

- Required documents for academic applications: educational certificates, academic history
- University admissions and scholarship options
- Education and living costs for students in the destination country
- Transition plans for converting student status to permanent residency after graduation

Financial and Economic Evaluation

- Assessing current financial situation: savings, current income, liquid and non-liquid assets
- Recommending the best immigration option with high success potential based on financial status
- Methods for transferring assets to the destination country
- Investment opportunities in the destination country

Legal and Regulatory Review

Reviewing immigration laws and regulations of the destination country

Examining immigration offenses and restrictions

Understanding the rights and benefits of immigrants

Explaining the latest rules and limitations for temporary and permanent residency

Language and Cultural Evaluation

Assessing the client's language proficiency

Required language proficiency: language tests and requirements for various immigration programs

Family Evaluation

Reviewing family status: number of family members, spouse's employment status, education and age of children

Assessing the option for simultaneous or separate family migration

Required Documentation

Identification and personal documents: passport, birth certificate, marriage certificate

Educational and professional documents: official translations of academic and work credentials

Financial documents: proof of financial capability, bank statements, property ownership

Legal certificates: criminal record check, medical certificates

Full preparation of documents for submission to immigration authorities

Setting timelines for collecting and submitting each document
